## Continuing Teacher Development Course run by Australian Teachers' Alliance (ATA) 5-7 July 2024, Gatton Campus

This course is being run in the two days prior to the Winter School, at the same venue. It is open to all teachers regardless of whether you are a member of ATA or not. The course will cover some of the following skills: dance analysis, observing and correcting faults in steps and handling, recapping and use of music/musician.
