Getting to Gatton

We have written to everyone who requested transport to/from Gatton. If you asked for transport and have not received an email, please get in touch as soon as possible.

The CBD pick-up point for our transport is **NOT** the Roma Street Transit Centre as previously advised. Our bus will pick up from Roma Street, opposite the Transit Centre, at the bus stop just outside the Police Station (200 Roma Street). Look for the RSCDS sign on the side of the bus.

If you are unlucky enough to miss our bus service to Gatton, you could catch a Greyhound bus. ([Greyhound website](#).) If travelling by Greyhound or another coach company, you will be dropped off at the bus stop on the Warrego Highway, adjacent to Gatton campus. It is a long walk from there, so please phone one of the numbers below* if you need a lift from the Warrego Highway bus stop to the campus.
